RESOLUTION R-2025-89

A Resolution of the County of Lawrence Providing a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Allegheny County, Armstrong County, Butler County, Cambria County, Fayette County, Indiana County, Mercer County, Somerset County, Washington County and Westmoreland County pertaining to the governance, operation and maintenance of a Regional Public Safety Radio System Controller Switch for the Inter-County Regional Radio System (ICORRS).

WHEREAS, the Inter-county Regional Radio System (ICORRS) is a regional digital interoperability public safety radio system providing for delivery of voice and data services to support the on-going public safety and non-public safety related activities in Allegheny County, Armstrong County, Butler County, Cambria County, Fayette County, Indiana County, Lawrence County, Mercer County, Somerset County, Washington County and Westmoreland County; and

WHEREAS, in mutual cooperation with Armstrong County, Butler County, Cambria County, Indiana County, Lawrence County, Mercer County, Fayette County, Somerset County, Washington and Westmoreland County (hereinafter "Participating Counties") as members of ICORRS, the governance, operation and maintenance of hardware and software for a Project 25 digital radio network joint communications master site (Hereinafter "P25"), located at the Westmoreland County Department of Public Safety, 9-1-1 Center, and the DSR Master, located at Allegheny County Department of Public Safety, 9-1-1 Center, the cost of which is to be shared equally by the Participating Counties on an annual payment basis. The master site and/or DSR upgrade and expansion created a common, standards driven, P25 platform that will support the continued growth of a wide-area fully interoperable regional radio communications system among the participating counties, and contains all of the network servers, routers, switching infrastructure, system controllers, and management components that will make the wide-area P25 network fully operational.", and

WHEREAS, cost sharing agreements are authorized pursuant to the Intergovernmental Cooperation

WHEREAS, routine development of long range system plans, monitoring of system operations and development and support of interoperability processes and procedures will be governed by the Radio Communications Charter and Governance Procedures for ICORRS Users, attached as Exhibit "A" hereto, and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Participating Counties agree to enter into an Inter-County ICORRS MOU with respect to the ICORRS regional digital interoperability public safety radio system providing for delivery of voice and data services to support the on-going public safety and non-public safety related activities in substantially the form set forth in the Current ICORRS Motorola Service Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit "B", and

- 1. The Participating Counties agree to share the costs of operating and maintaining a Regional Public Safety Radio System Controller Switch for ICORRS and provide assurances to one another to support same equally splitting the reasonable and necessary costs associated therewith.. Should any additional counties of the Commonwealth join this MOU, the cost to each participating county will be proportionally reduced. Thus, the cost to a participating county will be the fractional quotient of the numerator, which shall be 1, divided by the denominator which shall be the total number of counties then participating in this MOU.
- 2. The duration of this MOU shall continue until jointly terminated by the parties by mutual agreement.
- 3. Any county may withdraw from its participation in this MOU but shall provide a one-year written notification to the other participating counties as to their intent to terminate their participation in this MOU.
- 4. A Participating County that elects to withdraw from participation in this MOU will have no rights to utilize the regional switch or to retain its portion of ownership in any said equipment as that equipment supports vital public operations for the remaining parties to this MOU. Any Participating County that withdraws from this MOU agrees to pay for the cost of system reconfiguration and agrees to procure its own system switch. Said payment of system reconfiguration costs and cost to obtain its own system switch by a county that has withdrawn from participation in this MOU shall be considered by the remaining counties to be the liquidated damages to which the remaining counties are entitled with no further recourse available to the remaining counties against any county or counties that choose to withdraw from participation in this MOU.
- 5. The parties to this MOU agree that its main purpose is to provide for the sharing of the operations and maintenance of a Regional Public Safety Radio System Controller Switch and Disaster Support Recovery for ICORRS.
- 6. Subject to those obligations placed on a participating County contained in Exhibit "A", no organizational structure is necessary for the administration or implementation of this MOU.
- 7. Subject to the fractional share of costs as contemplated in paragraph 1, no additional real or personal property of any Participating County shall be pledged or otherwise used to carry out its obligations hereunder.

- 8. No new governmental entity will be formed to effectuate this MOU.
- 9. This MOU shall not be binding on any of the Participating Counties until all Participating Counties have executed this MOU.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED BY THE LAWRENCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS that authorization is given to execute on behalf of the Lawrence County Department of Public Safety, all documents related to the attached Motorola Master Site Service Agreement. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to sign all documentation.
