

## NOTICE OF GENERAL PRIMARY

In accordance with the provisions of Section 906 of the Act of June 3, 1937, P.L. 1333, as amended, known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code", the Lawrence County Board of Elections hereby gives notice of the offices for which candidates are to be nominated at the Primary Election, May 19, 2026.

The following parties have polled the percentage of votes required under the provisions of Section 801(a) of the Pennsylvania Election Code, to qualify as a party within the State and are therefore eligible to nominate their candidates at the Primary Election, May 19, 2026.

### DEMOCRATIC REPUBLICAN

The following are the public offices and number to be elected at the General Election:

**GOVERNOR** - Vote for One-All Precincts within Lawrence County

**LT. GOVERNOR** - Vote for One - All Precincts within Lawrence County

**REPRESENTATIVE IN CONGRESS** - District 16 - Vote for One -  
All Precincts within Lawrence County

**SENATOR IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY** - District 50 - Vote for One -  
Part of LAWRENCE County consisting of the CITY of New Castle and the TOWNSHIPS of Hickory, Mahoning, Neshannock, North Beaver, Plain Grove, Pulaski, Scott, Shenango, Slippery Rock, Taylor, Union, Washington and Wilmington and the BOROUGHs of Bessemer, New Wilmington, S.N.P.J. and Volant

**REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY** - District 8 - Vote for One -  
Part of LAWRENCE County consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Little Beaver, Perry, Plain Grove, Scott, Slippery Rock, Washington and Wayne and the BOROUGHs of Ellport, Ellwood City (Lawrence County Portion), Enon Valley, New Beaver, Volant and Wampum.

**REPRESENTATIVE IN THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY** - District 9 - Vote for One -  
Part of LAWRENCE County consisting of the CITY of New Castle and the TOWNSHIPS of Hickory, Mahoning, Neshannock, North Beaver, Pulaski, Shenango, Taylor, Union and Wilmington and the BOROUGHs of Bessemer, New Wilmington, S.N.P.J.

The following are the party offices and number to be elected at the Primary Election, May 19, 2026:

**MEMBER OF THE DEMOCRATIC STATE COMMITTEE** -  
Vote for not more than TWO - One Male and One Female  
All Precincts within Lawrence County

**MEMBER OF THE LAWRENCE COUNTY DEMOCRATIC COMMITTEE** -  
Vote for not more than TWO - Electing One Male and One Female -  
Each Precinct in Lawrence County

**MEMBER OF THE REPUBLICAN STATE COMMITTEE** -  
Vote for not more than THREE - One Male and One Female and One of Either  
All Precincts within Lawrence County
