

LAWRENCE COUNTY ELECTION BOARD MEETING
PUBLIC MEETING
MINUTES OF Monday, November 6, 2023

The Lawrence County Election Board Meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag followed by a Moment of Silence.

The Lawrence County Election Board Meeting of Monday, November 6, 2023, was called to order by **Commissioner Brian D. Burick**, at 10:00 am at the Lawrence County Commissioners Meeting Room. Deputy Chief Clerk, Vanessa Bayless called the roll. Those in attendance were **Frank Piccari, Jack Seltzer, Tim Germani, Loretta Spielvogel, Susan Kite, Jason Medure, Debbie Wachter, New Castle News**. It was stated for the record that the meeting is being taped. Those wishing to speak shall be given five minutes. If they need more time, they are to see the Deputy Chief Clerk at another time, and she will arrange for them to meet with the Commissioners. Those speaking are to state for the record their names, addresses and the nature of their business.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. The minutes of October 10, 2023, were approved with the corrected spelling of Mr. Germani.

Moved by Mr. Seltzer, seconded by Mr. Piccari to accept and file the minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

Mr. Germani gave the Election Director's Report. He stated as of this morning, which did not include today's incoming mail, there have been 4,632 mail in ballots returned out of 5,737 that were mailed out. Voters have until 8 pm tomorrow to return their ballots, when the polls close. From that total returned, there are 1,168 Republican ballots, 3,246 Democrat ballots and 215 various other parties.

The Courthouse will be open tomorrow at 7AM for pre-canvassing ballots. The three (3) polling locations that were changed are Neshannock 7 & 8 that were at the Hutchison Center are now at The Meadows and The YZone, respectively. Also, Shenango 6 has moved to the Independent Methodist Church.

There are 55,465 total registered voters. Democrat voters total 21,076, Republican voters total 27,639, Libertarian voters total 249 and other voters total 6,501.

There will be an Election Return Board meeting on Monday, November 13, 2023.

Request to keep the Board open.

Motion to recess to call of the Chair at 10:10 am by Mr. Seltzer, seconded by Mr. Piccari. Motion carried 3-0.
