There will be 11,000 total that will have been mailed once they are completed. Mr. Germani reported that he has a sample ballot for anyone wishing to view it. Petitions for all offices can be picked up beginning on February 14, 2023, through March 7, 2023 for anyone wishing to have their name on the county ballot. There are 2 polling areas that are unable to accommodate the county this election, therefore; the county will be looking for 2 new polling places. ES&S presented a demonstration on February 8, 2023 regarding electronic poll books.
